

# Water-in-fuel alert

## D-TX FUEL SAFE:

**D**uring the 15 years Mike Folan spent as an engineer on the Thames, the vast majority of breakdowns he saw in marine engines were caused by water in the fuel.

Had the owners or operators of the boats known about the water, they would have been able to do something about it before serious problems arose. But Mike's experience suggests that few people check the filter or drain the tank as a matter of course.

That's why he set about developing the D-TX Fuel Safe, which fits in the fuel pipe between the filter and the engine and sounds an alarm if it detects more than a critical amount of water. It doesn't tackle the cause of the problem, but lets you know that you have one.
